This supplemental award is requested due to increased usage by other departments. The bid was originally only for the Department of Building Operations covering the School Board Administration Building and Annex, however, it is also now being used by the Department of Transportation. This is a first time bid and no history of past purchases was available to determine more accurate estimated bid quantities. This year's usage has averaged \$6,825.35 per month. The supplemental amount requested is based on the average monthly expenditure, times the twelve (12) month contract period, minus the original award amount.
