SUBJECT: AWARD OF REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS #182-ZZ10 – COURSEWARE FOR PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT 2000-2001 (REBID)

The purpose of this Request For Proposals, opened on March 21, 2000, is to establish a contract, to provide, at firm prices, courseware for professional development delivered via distance learning technologies, for the Division of Instructional Technology and Media Support Services. This is a term proposal which states that the Board may purchase quantities, as may be required, at the unit price proposed, but is not obligated to purchase any guaranteed amount. Of 20 vendors sent proposal forms or card notices of this advertised proposal, 6 responded, with 2 proposals meeting specifications, 2 non-responsive proposals (proposals did not comply with the indemnification requirements), 1 proposal not meeting specifications (did not present oral presentation), and 1 no proposal.
