SUBJECT: NAMING OF SCHOOLS

The Educational Facilities Naming Committees met on August 16, 2000, reviewed all documents submitted for consideration and present the following recommendations:

1. Miami Lakes Technical Center – With the construction of additional spaces, this center will be converted to a senior high school. The committee, composed of Ms. Perla Tabares Hantman, Chair, Mr. Demetrio Pérez, Jr., M.S., and Dr. Solomon C. Stinson, recommends that the name of this center be changed to Miami Lakes Educational Center.
2. Robert Morgan Technical Center – With the construction of additional spaces, this center will be converted to a senior high school. The committee, composed of Ms. Perla Tabares Hantman, Chair, Ms. Manty Sabatés Morse and Mr. G. Holmes Braddock, recommends that the name of this center be changed to Robert Morgan Technical Arts Senior High School.
3. North Carol City Elem. – The committee, composed of Ms. Perla Tabares Hantman, Chair, Dr. Marta Pérez and Dr. Robert B. Ingram, recommends that the name of this center be changed to Barbara Hawkins Elementary School.
4. State School "VV-1" (Middle School) located at S. W. 47 Street & 157 Avenue – The committee, composed of Ms. Perla Tabares Hantman, Chair, Ms. Betsy Kaplan and Mr. G. Holmes Braddock, recommends that this center be named Lamar Louise Curry Middle School.
5. State School "PPP" (Senior High School) located at S. W. 56 Street & 162 Avenue – The committee, composed of Ms. Perla Tabares Hantman, Chair, Ms. Betsy Kaplan, and Mr. G. Holmes Braddock, recommends that this center be named John A. Ferguson Senior High School.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida:

1. change the name of Miami Lakes Technical Center to Miami Lakes Educational Center;
2. change the name of Robert Morgan Technical Center to Robert Morgan Technical Arts Senior High School;
3. change the name of North Carol City Elementary School to Barbara Hawkins Elementary School;
4. name State School "VV-1", Lamar Louise Curry Middle School;
and,
5. name State School "PPP", John A. Ferguson Senior High School.
