**SUBJECT: DISMISSAL OF EMPLOYEE  
TONY A. BRINSON - CUSTODIAN  
ALLAPATTAH MIDDLE SCHOOL**

On August 29, 2000, the Superintendent of Schools sent the following letter to Mr. Samuel Cook:

I am exercising my responsibility as Superintendent of Schools and recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of September 13, 2000, that the School Board suspend you and initiate dismissal proceedings against you from your current position as Custodian, at Allapattah Middle School, effective at the close of the workday, September 13, 2000, for just cause, including, but not limited to, excessive absenteeism, misconduct in office, gross insubordination, conviction of a crime involving moral turpitude, and violation of School Board Rules 6Gx13-4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties, 6Gx13-4-1.08, Violence in the Workplace, and 6Gx13-5D-1.07, Corporal Punishment-Prohibited. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 230.03(2), 230.23(5)(f), 231.3605, 231.44, and 447.209, Florida Statutes.

If you wish to contest your suspension and dismissal, you must request a hearing in writing within 20 calendar days of the receipt of notice of the Board action, in which case, formal charges will be filed and a hearing will be held before an impartial hearing officer.

**RECOMMENDED:** That effective September 13, 2000, at the close of the workday, the School Board suspend and initiate dismissal proceedings against Mr. Tony A. Brinson, Custodian, at Allapattah Middle School, pending the outcome of a hearing, if requested.
