**SUBJECT: AWARD BID #273-ZZ09 – SANITATION SERVICES AND CLEANING
SUPPLY PROGRAM**

The purpose of this bid, opened on August 8, 2000, is to establish a contract, to purchase, at a firm unit price, quantities, as may be required, of sanitation and cleaning supply services, for the Department of Food and Nutrition. This is a term bid which states that the Board may purchase quantities, as may be required, at the unit price bid, but is not obligated to purchase any guaranteed amount. Of 153 vendors sent bid forms or card notices of this advertised bid, 16 responded, with 5 bids meeting specifications and 11 no bids. The district will receive a savings of approximately \$223,391.30, over last year's award.
