SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT GRANT AWARDS FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR FUNDING THE FLORIDA LEARN AND SERVE AMERICA GRANT PROGRAM, EFFECTIVE AS OF SEPTEMBER 1, 2000 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2001

The Florida Department of Education issued a Request for Proposals to public schools for service-learning projects. These funds are part of the Florida Learn and Serve America Grant Program funded under the Corporation for National Service. The goal of the program is to expand service-learning opportunities for K-12 youth through the integration of service into the academic curricula. All schools and district offices were invited to participate in this grant initiative via the Federal Programs and Grants Administration website.

Grant funds have been awarded in the total amount of \$42,778 to fund the following projects:

- North Miami Beach Senior High School received \$3,961 for the Readers are Leaders Project;
- MAST Academy received \$2,746 for the Ecological Restoration of Cape Florida Project;
- Charles R. Drew Middle School received \$6,713 for the Books "R" Us Project;
- Campbell Drive Middle School received \$11,858 for the Campbell Cares Project; and
- The Division of Community Participation received \$17,500 for the Intergenerational Youth Council Project.

There is a required 33 percent match for new applicants, 50 percent match for secondyear applicants and 100 percent match for third-year applicants. The match will be met by the schools and district office through the contribution of space, technical assistance, administrative and clerical support, materials, and support from community and business partners.

During the 1999-2000 school year, Miami-Dade County Public Schools received funds in the amount of \$43,978 under this initiative.

Official notification relative to this grant award was received on August 21, 2000. The grant award allows for the reimbursement of expenditures from September 1, 2000.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- 1. accept grant awards from the Florida Department of Education, in the total amount of \$42,778, for funding under the Florida Learn and Serve America Grant Program, effective as of September 1, 2000 through August 31, 2001;
- 2. extend these grant awards, at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if it is deemed necessary in order to complete the scope of the projects; and
- 2. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
