SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR FUNDING UNDER THE INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES EDUCATION ACT (IDEA), TO FUND IDEA, PART B, DISCRETIONARY SUPPLEMENT, EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 14, 2000 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2001

Authorization is being requested to accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), to fund IDEA, Part B, Discretionary Supplement, in the amount of \$695,198.

The IDEA, Part B, provides support to state education agencies which are in compliance with all rules and regulations mandated in the law. The basic tenants of the law require state and local agencies to provide a free and appropriate public education for handicapped students.

IDEA, Part B, Discretionary Supplement allocation provides Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) with additional funds to assist in the costs related to the implementation of the revised individual education plan.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami- Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education, in the amount of \$695,198, for funding under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), to fund IDEA, Part B, Discretionary Supplement, effective September 14, 2000 - June 30, 2001;
2. extend the grant award, at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if deemed necessary, in order to fully expend the grant award and thus complete the scope of the project; and
3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
