Production Technician, at Southwood Middle School, effective at the close of the workday, October 11, 2000, for just cause, including, but not limited to, improper conduct, misconduct in office, immorality, violation of School Board Rules 6Gx13-4A1.09, Employee-Student Relationships, and 6GX13-4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 230.03(2), 230.23(5)(f), 231.3605, and 447.209, Florida Statutes.

If you wish to contest your suspension and dismissal, you must request a hearing in writing within 20 calendar days of the receipt of notice of the Board action, in which case, formal charges will be filed and a hearing will be held before an impartial hearing officer.

RECOMMENDED: That effective October 11, 2000, at the close of the workday, the School Board suspend and initiate dismissal proceedings against Mr. Colin A. Kendrew, T.V. Production Technician, at Southwood Middle School, pending the outcome of a hearing, if requested.
