SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH THE SOUTH FLORIDA EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING CONSORTIUM TO ESTABLISH FOUR ONE-STOP SATELLITE CENTERS, EFFECTIVE AS OF OCTOBER 1, 2000 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2001

Authorization is requested for the Superintendent to accept funds, in the amount of \$500,000, from the South Florida Employment and Training Consortium (TEC) and to enter into a contractual agreement to establish and provide training for four One-Stop Satellite Centers. The funding will provide core services and support for participants in the Workforce/Welfare Transition Programs at The English Center, Lindsey Hopkins Technical Education Center, Robert Morgan Vocational Technical Institute, and South Dade Skills Center. These centers will offer employment information, assessment, and job placement for targeted populations including veterans, youth aged 18-21, dislocated workers, individuals with disabilities, and farm workers.

Official notification of this grant award was received on September 28, 2000, which is after the effective start date of the grant. The grant award allows for the reimbursement of expenditures from October 1, 2000.

No local funds are required.

**RECOMMENDED:** That the School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- accept a grant award from the South Florida Employment and Training Consortium, in the amount of \$500,000, and enter into a contractual agreement, in the amount of \$500,000, to establish four One-Stop Satellite Centers, effective as of October 1, 2000 through June 30, 2001;
- extend this contractual agreement at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if deemed necessary, in order to complete the scope of the project; and
- 3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency with such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
