SUBJECT: THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA v. CAROLE ABRIL - DOAH CASE NO. 00-1142

On March 15, 2000, the School Board suspended teacher Carole Abril from her employment with The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, and instituted dismissal proceedings against her. A hearing was requested and the case was tried on July 14, 2000, before DOAH Administrative Law Judge Stuart M. Lerner in Miami, Florida.

By recommended order entered September 8, 2000, the Administrative Law Judge sustained the School Board's charge of unsatisfactory performance and recommended that the School Board enter a final order terminating Carole Abril's employment with the School Board.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, adopt the recommended order of the Administrative Law Judge in DOAH Case No. 00-1142, terminating the employment of Carole Abril with The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, as of March 15, 2000, and denying any claim for back pay.
