SUBJECT: REQUEST TO REVIEW THE DUTIES OF THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND COMPLIANCE AUDITS AND THE CHIEF AUDITOR

The Office of Management and Compliance Audits was established per School Board Rule 6Gx13-2C-1.14 as an independent appraisal activity within the school system. The office is to assist the School Board and the administration by reviewing the activities of the school system, the integrity of its records and the general effectiveness of its operations.

The office reports to Management and Accountability, and its reports are presented to the administration, the School Board Audit Committee, and the School Board.

Because of the recent discussions about enhancing the overall accountability of the school system to the public, it is recommended that the Superintendent of Schools review the office's duties and responsibilities and bring back a report to the School Board on any suggested changes to the School Board Rule, after consultation with the School Board Audit Committee.
