SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION FOR THE SUPERINTENDENT OR DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A PERFORMANCE-BASED CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH PARTNERS FOR AMERICAN VOCATIONAL EDUCATION (PAVE), WHEREBY THE AGENCY WILL PROVIDE EMPLOYER-BASED, CUSTOMIZED TRAINING FOR A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$92,700, FROM NOVEMBER 16, 2000 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2001

Authorization is requested for the Superintendent to enter into a performance-based contractual agreement with Partners for American Vocational Education (PAVE). The agency will provide customized, employer-based skills training in carpentry-related areas. PAVE will recruit, train, and place in employment a maximum of 30 students, for a total amount not to exceed \$92,700 if all deliverables are met. All persons receiving training and services will be using Miami-Dade County Public Schools' (M-DCPS) facilities and will be registered with the Florida Department of Education as M-DCPS students.

This contract has been in effect for over six years.

The appropriation for this item is included in the General Fund of the 2000-2001 Adopted Budget under Fund 0100, Function 5338, Program 6230, Object 5390, Location 7602.

Mr. Dean Griffin is the Chief Executive Officer of PAVE.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent or designee to enter into a performance-based contractual agreement with Partners for American Vocational Education (PAVE), whereby the agency will provide employer-based, customized training for a cost not to exceed \$92,700, from November 16, 2000 through June 30, 2001.

The appropriation for this item is included in the General Fund of the 2000-2001 Adopted Budget.
