SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT THREE FAMILIES AS EDUCATORS GRANT AWARDS FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR FUNDING FAMILY LITERACY PROJECTS UNDER THE ADULT EDUCATION AND FAMILY LITERACY ACT AT MIAMI BEACH ADULT AND COMMUNITY EDUCATION CENTER, ROBERT MORGAN VOCATIONAL TECHNICAL INSTITUTE, AND NORTH MIAMI BEACH COMMUNITY EDUCATION CENTER EFFECTIVE AS OF JULY 1, 2000 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2001

The Florida Department of Education issued a Request for Proposals under the Adult Education and Family Literacy Act to fund projects that promote literacy and increase basic educational skills among adults living in Florida.

The Office of Workforce Development Education submitted grant applications for projects designed to provide parents with the necessary skills to become full partners in the educational development of their children. The following projects were funded:

- The <u>Biscayne Family Reading Project</u> at Miami Beach Adult and Community Education Center will bring parents and elementary school children together to learn English, read together, and learn about their cultural integration in the South Florida community through a partnership between the Miami Beach Adult and Community Education Center, Biscayne Elementary, and the Historical Museum of Southern Florida. Funding in the amount of \$35,535 will provide personnel, professional and technical requirements, pupil transportation, books, newspapers, supplies, and software.
- The Robert Morgan Vocational Technical Institute Family Literacy Project
 will increase family participation in the educational process, helping
 parents view education as the key to success for both themselves and
 their families. The project will enhance parenting skills, knowledge of child
 development, and technology skills. It will also provide parent and child
 time together for literacy activities. Funding in the amount of \$50,000 will
 be used for supplies, books, computers, software, personnel, and travel.

The North Miami Beach Community Education Center Project Literacy
 <u>Works!</u> is committed to the philosophy that literacy is a family affair. By
 promoting reading, it will offer adults and their children the opportunity to
 develop English language acquisition skills. Funding in the amount of
 \$41,828 will provide for materials, equipment, books, materials, and
 personnel.

Official notification of these grant awards was received during the months of September and October 2000, which is after the effective start date of the grant. The grant awards allow for the reimbursement of expenditures from July 1, 2000.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED:

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- 1. accept three Families as Educators grant awards from the Florida Department of Education, for funding family literacy projects under the Adult Education and Family Literacy Act at Miami Beach Adult and Community Education Center in the amount of \$35,535; Robert Morgan Vocational Technical Institute in the amount of \$50,000; and North Miami Beach Community Education Center in the amount of \$41,828, effective as of July 1, 2000 through June 30, 2001;
- 2. extend this grant award, at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if deemed necessary, in order to complete the scope of the project; and
- 3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency, such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
