SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR FUNDING THE PREKINDERGARTEN/KINDERGARTEN READING PROGRAM, AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH ELECTRONIC EDUCATION TO IMPLEMENT THE WATERFORD EARLY READING PROGRAM, EFFECTIVE AS OF JULY 1, 2000 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2001

The Florida Department of Education, under the General Appropriations Act, provides funds to develop a pilot program to improve skills for students in prekindergarten and kindergarten.

Funds provided by this grant will allow for the implementation of the Waterford Early Reading Program in four level 2 schools. This program model is one strategy that is used to enhance and accelerate language acquisition and reading skills for young children. The project is also designed as a pilot to support a larger infusion of technology-based instruction throughout the district's low performing schools and will be evaluated for future replication.

Funds in the amount of \$425,000 will serve prekindergarten and kindergarten students in the following elementary schools: Kinloch Park, Laura C. Saunders, South Hialeah, and Mae M. Walters. The aforementioned schools are also participants in the Emergency Immigrant Education Program, and demonstrated a need to increase the availability of this research-based program to more prekindergarten and kindergarten students.

Authorization is being requested to enter into a contractual agreement with Electronic Education, at a cost not to exceed \$403,410, to implement the Waterford Early Reading Program. The remaining funds will be used to purchase supplies, equipment and substitutes.

Official notification relative to this grant award was received on September 5, 2000, which is after the effective start date of the grant. The grant award allows for the reimbursement of expenditures from July 1, 2000.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED:

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education, in the amount of \$425,000, for funding the Prekindergarten/Kindergarten Reading Program, and enter into a contractual agreement with Electronic Education, in an amount not to exceed \$403,410, to implement the Waterford Early Reading Program, effective as of July 1, 2000 through June 30, 2001;
- extend this grant award and contractual agreement, at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if deemed necessary, in order to complete the scope of the project; and
- 3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency, such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
