SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A RADIO COMMUNITY SERVICE GRANT AWARD FROM THE CORPORATION FOR PUBLIC BROADCASTING FOR SCHOOL BOARD RADIO STATION WLRN-FM, EFFECTIVE AS OF OCTOBER 1, 2000 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2002

During the 1999-00 school year, the Corporation for Public Broadcasting (CPB) provided a Radio Community Service Grant in the amount of \$209,562, to support community education programming on School Board Radio Station WLRN-FM. For the 2000-02 school years, Miami-Dade County Public Schools is eligible for an entitlement Radio Community Service Grant in the amount of \$238,271.

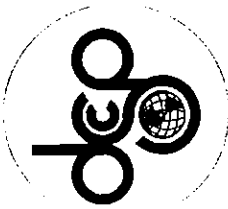
Funds provided by this grant will be used to continue the employment of two radio associate producers, one producer, one assistant producer, as well as part-time and overtime personnel. In addition, \$65,525 or approximately 27.5% of the grant will be used to pay the cost of approximately eleven hours per week of WLRN-FM programming that is provided by Public Radio International (PRI) including programs such as *A Prairie Home Companion*, *Market Place*, *Zorba Paster on Your Health*, *Riverwalk*, and *This American Life*.

Official notification of this grant award was received on October 17, 2000, which is after the effective start date of the grant. The grant award allows for the reimbursement of expenditures from October 1, 2000.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida authorize the Superintendent:

1. to accept a Radio Community Service Grant award, in the amount of \$238,271, from the Corporation for Public Broadcasting for School Board Radio Station WLRN-FM, effective as of October 1, 2000 through September 30, 2002;
2. extend this grant award at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if deemed necessary, in order to fully expend the grant award and thus complete the scope of the project; and
3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
