**SUBJECT: COMMISSIONING OF PRECISION ENGINEERING & SURVEYING, INC.,
TO PERFORM LAND SURVEYING CONSULTING SERVICES**

Staff has completed the selection process for consultants to perform Land Surveying Consulting Services.

Twelve (12) firms applied and nine (9) were interviewed by the Selection Committee. Of these nine (9) firms, the following five firms were selected:

- Precision Engineering & Surveying, Inc.
- E.R. Brownell & Associates, Inc.
- Ludovici & Orange Consulting Engineers, Inc.
- J.H. Manucy, Inc.
- J. Bonfill & Associates, Inc.

Negotiations with Precision Engineering & Surveying, Inc., regarding fees, scope of work and other related terms have been successfully completed. The agreement shall include the following negotiated provisions:

1. The negotiated fees will be paid on an agreed not-to-exceed hourly basis for the personnel required for each assignment utilizing the following hourly rates:

2. The agreement provides for indemnification and hold harmless provisions to the Board, its members and employees, due to negligent acts by the consultant. The consultant shall maintain no less than a \$300,000 Professional Liability insurance policy and a \$300,000 Commercial/General Liability insurance policy.
3. The Board shall not be obligated to expend any specific amount under this contract; however, the consultant's total billings shall not exceed \$300,000 per year.
4. The term for this agreement shall be for a three (3) year period, commencing November 15, 2000 and expiring November 14, 2003, with the second and third years being at the Board's option. Since the second and third years are at the Board's option, each additional year must first be approved and ratified by the Board prior to its commencement.

The Principal/Owner for Precision Engineering & Surveying, Inc., is Mr. Michael O. Egbebike.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, commission the firm of Precision Engineering & Surveying, Inc., to perform Land Surveying Consulting Services for a three (3) year term, commencing November 15, 2000 and expiring November 14, 2003, with the second and third years being at the Board's option, for the following considerations:

- 1) negotiated terms and conditions as stated above;
- 2) since the second and third years are at the Board's option, each additional year must first be approved and ratified by the Board prior to its commencement;
- 3) the agreement provides for cancellation by the Board with or without cause, upon thirty (30) days written notice to the firm. The firm may terminate the agreement, only with cause, upon thirty (30) days written notice to the Board; and
- 4) the total billings under this contract shall not exceed \$300,000 per year, without the Board being obligated to expend any specific amount.

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
