**SUBJECT: REQUEST TO AMEND THE 2001 STATE LEGISLATIVE PROGRAM
TO MODIFY TIME SPEED ZONES ARE ENFORCED**

Amend the Board's 2001 State Legislative Program to modify the time speed zones are enforced. Florida Statutes, Section 316.1895 states that speed limits may be in force only during 30 minutes before, during and after the period of time pupils are arriving at a regularly-scheduled breakfast program or a regularly-scheduled school session and leaving a regularly-scheduled school session.

Many of our high school students leave our school sites for lunch or leave to attend to employment opportunities. In an attempt to keep our students safe, the time frame in which speed zones would be enforced should be changed statutorily to reflect current conditions.
