SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION FOR THE SUPERINTENDENT TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES RENDERED BY PIERRE TOUSSAINT HAITIAN CATHOLIC CENTER, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$12,000, FOR THE USE OF FACILITIES, CUSTODIAL SERVICES, AND UTILITIES, FROM JULY 1, 2000 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2001

Authorization is requested for the Superintendent to enter into a contractual agreement with Pierre Toussaint Haitian Catholic Center located at 110 Northwest 62 Street, Miami, Florida. The contractual agreement specifies the use of classroom space by Miami-Dade County Public Schools personnel for educational purposes, parking for teachers and students, maintenance and custodial services, and utilities in an amount not to exceed \$12,000. Funds requested will partially reimburse Pierre Toussaint Haitian Catholic Center for costs incurred for providing services. Classes will be offered Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 2:10 p.m. and from 6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m.

The appropriation for this item is included in the General Fund of the 2000-2001 Adopted Budget under Fund 0100, Function 7300, Program 7050, Object 5360, Location 8139.

Dr. Richard Turcotte is the CEO of Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of Miami, Inc.

This agreement has been in effect for 17 years.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to enter into a contractual agreement for services rendered by Pierre Toussaint Haitian Catholic Center, in an amount not to exceed \$12,000, for the use of facilities, custodial services, and utilities, from July 1, 2000 through June 30, 2001.

The appropriation for this item is included in the General Fund of the 2000-2001 Adopted Budget.
