**SUBJECT: AWARD BID #038-AA02 - FUEL STORAGE TANKS AND
MONITORING SYSTEMS, INSPECTIONS/SERVICE AND REPAIR
CONTRACT**

The purpose of this bid, opened on October 26, 2000, is to establish a contract, to purchase, at firm unit prices, quantities, as may be required, of fuel storage tanks and monitoring systems, inspections/service and repairs, for Maintenance and Operations. This is a term bid which states that the Board may purchase quantities, as may be required, at the unit price bid, but is not obligated to purchase any guaranteed amount. Of 47 vendors sent bid forms or card notices of this advertised bid, 11 responded, with 9 bids meeting specifications, and 2 no bids. This award represents a savings of approximately 42%, of the average unit cost, compared to the previous award.

- Item 1 - Maintenance, inspection and/or service of aboveground fuel storage tanks and monitoring systems @ \$25 each.
 - Item 2 - Maintenance, inspection and/or service of underground fuel storage tanks and monitoring systems @ \$25 each.
 - Item 3 - Labor rate for fuel storage tanks and monitoring fuel equipment repair @ \$35 per hour.
 - Item 4 - Emergency urgent service call for aboveground storage tanks @ \$70 each.
 - Item 5 - Emergency urgent service call for underground fuel storage tanks @ \$70 each.
 - Item 6 - Percentage of discount off list @ 15% discount.
2. Authorize the Bureau of Procurement and Materials Management to purchase up to the total estimated amount of \$65,274.85. The award shall be made subject to the resolution of bid protests, if any.
