RATIFICATION OF NEW THREE YEAR LABOR CONTRACT BETWEEN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND THE AMERICAN FEDERATION OF STATE, COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES (AFSCME), LOCAL 1184

Negotiations on a successor labor contract between The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees (AFSCME), Local 1184 began on June 16, 2000. Negotiations concluded on February 5, 2001, with a tentative agreement on all provisions covering wages, hours, and terms and conditions of employment for all unit members. Significant elements of the new contract include:

- A three year successor agreement (effective July 1, 2000 through June 30, 2003) with a one year wage settlement (2000-2001);
- ► Contract reopener provisions Year Two (2000-2002) and Year Three (2002-2003);
- An increase in the wage differential paid to employees assigned to the second and third shifts;
- Codifies 12-month employees eligibility for Independence Day holiday pay;
- An increase in the Uniform Allowance during Year One (2000-2001) and Year Two (2001-2002);
- An increase in the Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) Certification incentive pay; and
- An increase in allocation to the Education Assistance Fund.

AFSCME bargaining unit members ratified the three year successor contract on February 13, 2001.

RECOMMENDED:
