**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION FOR THE SUPERINTENDENT TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH MIAMI-DADE COMMUNITY COLLEGE TO REIMBURSE SPECIFIED OPERATING EXPENSES RELATED TO SERVICES RENDERED BY THE NEW WORLD SCHOOL OF THE ARTS, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$844,299, FROM JULY 1, 2000 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2001**

The purpose of this 2000-2001 contractual agreement is to reimburse Miami-Dade Community College for an agreed-upon share of the costs of security, plant operation and maintenance, duties performed by the deans, adjunct arts teachers and visiting performers, and classroom supplies. This reimbursement will not exceed \$844,299. This amount represents a decrease from the 1999-2000 contract since Miami-Dade Community College is no longer funding the parking permits for students and staff.

A copy of the amended contractual agreement will be provided to School Board Members under separate cover, and will be available for inspection in the Office of Board Recording Secretary, and the Citizen Information Center.

The appropriation for this item is included in the General Fund of the 2000-2001 Adopted Budget under Function 5103, Program 9117, Object 5310, Location 7901, Fund 0100.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to enter into a contractual agreement with Miami-Dade Community College to reimburse specified operating expenses related to services rendered by the New World School of the Arts, in an amount not to exceed \$844,299, from July 1, 2000 through June 30, 2001.

The appropriations for this item are included in the General Fund of the 2000-2001 Adopted Budget.
