EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, USI QUALITY ASSESSMENT**

The following recommendation is made in accordance with Board Rule 6Gx13-4A-1.16.

This open position is due to the incumbent's leave of absence.

Ms. Sanjie H. Sanjurjo, currently a Specialist, Assessment, MEP pay grade 19, Educational Planning and Quality Enhancement, is recommended for appointment to the open, budgeted position of Executive Director, Urban Systemic Initiative (USI) Quality Assessment, MEP pay grade 22, Bureau of Elementary, Secondary, and Workforce Development Education. Ms. Sanjurjo received a Bachelor of Arts Degree and a Master of Science Degree from the University of Miami, Coral Gables, Florida. Since 1970 to the present, Ms. Sanjurjo has been employed by Miami-Dade County Public Schools as a teacher; an educational specialist; a Coordinator I, Evaluation; a Staff Specialist, Assessment; and a Specialist, Assessment, her current position.
