**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT
AWARD FROM THE YMCA OF GREATER MIAMI, INC., FOR
FUNDING TEEN PREGNANCY PREVENTION SERVICES AND
ABSTINENCE EDUCATION; PROJECT CYCLE: JANUARY 1, 2001
THROUGH JUNE 30, 2001**

The YMCA of Greater Miami, Inc., (YMCA) issued a request to contract with Miami-Dade County Public Schools, Bureau of Adult/Vocational, Alternative and Dropout Prevention Programs to provide Teen Pregnancy Prevention Services and Abstinence Education in six after-school care programs.

The grant is designed to provide direct instruction to fifth grade and middle school students using The Postponing Sexual Involvement curriculum, a co-educational abstinence-only program and the WISE GUYS curriculum, an abstinence-based direct instruction program for middle school boys. Both curricula are currently being used in the Education Now and Babies Later (ENABL) Program implemented by the Bureau of Alternative Education and Dropout Prevention Programs. The services will be provided to students enrolled in the following after-school care sites: Thomas Jefferson Middle School, Venetian Gardens Public Housing, International YMCA, Jose Marti Park, Lake Stevens Middle School, and Edison Court Public Housing Center.

Authorization is being requested to accept a cost reimbursement grant award from the YMCA in an amount not to exceed \$18,000. Funds will be used for hourly and/or contractual services, educational supplies, materials, and printing.

Official notification relative to this grant award was received on January 11, 2001. The budget period for the grant award allows for the reimbursement of expenditures beginning January 1, 2001.

The President and Chief Financial Officer of YMCA is Mr. John Turner.

No local funds are required.

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RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept a grant award from the YMCA of Greater Miami, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$18,000, for funding Teen Pregnancy Prevention Services and Abstinence Education; Project Cycle: January 1, 2001 through June 30, 2001;
2. extend this grant award, at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if deemed necessary, in order to fully expend the grant award and thus complete the scope of the project; and
3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
