**SUBJECT: DISMISSAL OF EMPLOYEE
KIMBERLY HALL - SCHOOL BUS DRIVER
SOUTH TRANSPORTATION CENTER**

On February 28, 2001, the Superintendent of Schools sent the following letter to Ms. Kimberly Hall:

I am exercising my responsibility as Superintendent of Schools and recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of March 14, 2001, that the School Board suspend you and initiate dismissal proceedings against you from your current position as School Bus Driver, South Transportation Center, effective at the close of the workday, March 14, 2001, for just cause, including, but not limited to, aggravated assault, violation of School Board Rules 6Gx13-4-1.08, Violence in the Workplace, and 6Gx13-4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 230.03(2), 230.23(5)(f), 231.3605, and 447.209, Florida Statutes.

If you wish to contest your suspension and dismissal, you must request a hearing in writing within 20 calendar days of the receipt of notice of the Board action, in which case, formal charges will be filed and a hearing will be held before an impartial hearing officer.

RECOMMENDED: That effective March 14, 2001, at the close of the workday, the School Board suspend and initiate dismissal proceedings against Ms. Kimberly Hall, School Bus Driver, at South Transportation Center, pending the outcome of a hearing, if requested.
