**SUBJECT: APPOINT AND ASSIGN :  
MANAGER III, (2)  
FOOD SERVICE QUALITY CONTROL**

The following recommendations are made in accordance with the Miami-Dade County Public Schools/Dade County School Administrators' Association labor contract.

One open budgeted position was approved by the School Board at its meeting of August 23, 2000, Agenda Item A-3; and one open budgeted position is due to the promotion of the incumbent.

**Ms. Allyson C. Bentley**, currently a Food Service Resource Specialist II, is recommended for appointment to the open, budgeted position of Manager III, Food Service Quality Control, pay grade 39, Department of Food and Nutrition. Ms. Bentley received a Bachelor of Science Degree from the University of Nebraska, Lincoln, Nebraska. Since 1991 to the present, Ms. Bentley has been employed by Miami-Dade County Public Schools as an On Site Support Specialist and a Food Service Resource Specialist II, her current position.

**Mr. Eduardo E. Vicaria** is recommended for appointment to the open, budgeted position of Manager III, Food Service Quality Control, pay grade 39, Department of Food and Nutrition. Mr. Vicaria received a Bachelor of Science Degree from Florida International University, Miami, Florida. From 1995 to 1997, Mr. Vicaria was employed by Miami Subs Grill, Miami, Florida, as a General Manager. Since 1997 to the present, Mr. Vicaria has been employed by the Sea View Hotel, Bal Harbour, Florida, as a Food and Beverage Manager.

These recommendations are the direct result of the Board-approved advertisement and selection process.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, appoint:

1. Ms. Allyson C. Bentley to the open, budgeted position of Manager III, Food Service Quality Control, pay grade 39, 12 months, and assign to the Department of Food and Nutrition, effective March 15, 2001, or as soon thereafter as can be facilitated; and
2. Mr. Eduardo E. Vicaria to the open, budgeted position of Manager III, Food Service Quality Control, pay grade 39, 12 months, and assign to the Department of Food and Nutrition, effective March 15, 2001, or as soon thereafter as can be facilitated.
