SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE WALTON FAMILY FOUNDATION, INC., FOR FUNDING THE CHOICE PUBLIC SCHOOLS PROGRAM; PROJECT CYCLE: APRIL 1, 2001 THROUGH APRIL 1, 2003

The Walton Family Foundation, Inc., provides funds to agencies in support of reform efforts to improve academic achievement to meet the challenges of school choice initiatives. The Office of Educational Planning and Quality Enhancement, Division of School Quality Improvement, has been awarded a Choice Public Schools Program Grant by the Walton Family Foundation, Inc. The program provides training, technical support, and an evaluation vehicle for schools implementing the Sterling Criteria for Organizational Performance Excellence. The purpose of the project is to provide resources to implement this research-based integrated management system.

During the 1999–2000 school year, \$35,000 was received by Miami-Dade County Public Schools from the Walton Family Foundation, Inc., for the planning phase of the program. During the 2000-2001 school year, funds in the amount of \$100,000 have been awarded for personnel, professional services, travel, and supplies. This amount is renewable each year for a total of \$300,000 over three years.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- 1. accept a grant award from the Walton Family Foundation, Inc., in the total amount of \$300,000, for funding the Choice Public Schools Program; Project Cycle: April 1, 2001 through April 1, 2003;
- extend this grant award, at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if deemed necessary, in order to fully expend the grant award and thus complete the scope of the project; and
- 3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
