SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION FOR THE SUPERINTENDENT OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENTS WITH THE FLORIDA INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING AND DESIGN TO CONTINUE A PRE-APPRENTICE RESIDENTIAL ELECTRICAL WIRING PROGRAM AT MIAMI-DOUGLAS MACARTHUR SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL SOUTH, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$33,042, AND BARBARA GOLEMAN SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$15,747, FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$48, 789, FROM JULY 1, 2001 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2002

Authorization is requested for the Superintendent or his designee to enter into contractual agreements with the Florida International University (FIU) College of Engineering and Design to continue the Pre-apprentice Residential Electrical Wiring Program at Miami-Douglas MacArthur Senior High School South, in an amount not exceed \$33,042, and Barbara Goleman Senior High School, in an amount not to exceed \$15,747, for total amount not to exceed \$48, 789, from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2002.

In August 1995, FIU began a Pre-apprentice Residential Electrical Wiring Program at Miami-Douglas MacArthur Senior High School South (Miami-Douglas MacArthur South) and in September 2000, began the same program at Barbara Goleman Senior High School (Barbara Goleman). The program provides internships and scholarships, attempts to place every student on a job in the field of residential electrical wiring, and allows students who earn A's and B's to receive FIU credits.

Approximately 45 students will be enrolled in the program at Miami-Douglas MacArthur South and 10 severely emotionally disturbed (SED) students will be enrolled at Barbara Goleman under the contractual agreements. The selected students at each center will attend the program and, at the end of the school year, may possibly earn an FIU credit.

To facilitate this program, FIU will provide the instructors and graduate students needed for the academic instruction, as well as educational materials and learning activities. Electricians from private industry will conduct safety seminars and demonstrations.

The Professional Services Contract Committee, established by School Board Rule 6Gx13-3F-1.021, reviewed these contractual agreements on April 30, 2001, and recommended that an exception to the rule regarding bids or Request for Proposals be granted as otherwise determined by the committee.

The appropriation for this item will be included in the 2001-2002 Tentative Budget to be recommended for adoption in July 2001 under the following structures:

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida:

1. authorize the Superintendent or his designee to enter into contractual agreements with the Florida International University College of Engineering and Design to continue a Pre-apprentice Residential Electrical Wiring Program at Miami-Douglas MacArthur Senior High School South, at a cost not to exceed \$33,042, and Barbara Goleman Senior High School, in an amount not to exceed \$15,747, for total amount not to exceed \$48,789, from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2002; and
2. grant an exception to Board Rule 6Gx13- 3F-1.021.

The appropriation for this item will be included in the 2001-2002 Tentative Budget to be recommended for adoption in July 2001.
