SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION FOR THE SUPERINTENDENT OR HIS DESIGNEE TO AMEND THE COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FOR THE CONTINUATION OF THE SATELLITE LEARNING CENTER AT MIAMI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, FROM JULY 1, 2001 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2002

On October 4, 1988, The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, entered into a cooperative agreement with Miami-Dade County to establish the Miami International Airport Satellite Learning Center on their property. This center is currently completing its 13th year of operation, serving approximately 160 students in kindergarten through fifth grade.

Authorization is requested for the Superintendent or his designee to amend the cooperative agreement with Miami-Dade County for the continuation of the Satellite Learning Center at the Miami International Airport from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2002. Ms. Esterlene Lewis, Associate Director of Minority Affairs, serves as the liaison for Miami International Airport.

A copy of the amendment to the cooperative agreement will be provided to Board Members under separate cover, and will be available for inspection in the Office of the Board Recording Secretary and the Citizen Information Center.

There will be no exchange of funds for this cooperative agreement.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent or his designee to amend the cooperative agreement with Miami-Dade County, for the continuation of the Satellite Learning Center at Miami International Airport, from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2002.

There will be no exchange of funds for this cooperative agreement.
