SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION FOR THE SUPERINTENDENT OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE TRAINING AND EMPLOYMENT COUNCIL OF SOUTH FLORIDA, TO PROVIDE TUTORIAL SERVICES TO SUMMER YOUTH EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING PROGRAM AND STAY-IN-SCHOOL PROGRAM STUDENTS, EFFECTIVE FROM JULY 1; 2001 THROUGH **SEPTEMBER 30, 2001**

Authorization is requested for the Superintendent or his designee to enter into a cooperative agreement with the Training and Employment Council of South Florida (TEC), to provide tutorial services to Summer Youth Employment and Training Program and Stay-In-School Program students. The TEC is contracting with organizations that provide tutoring using models that have been successful in serving large numbers of students.

These organizations will provide tutoring in reading and mathematics to eligible students after-school hours. They requested the use of the Miami-Dade County Public Schools' computer labs that will become the primary places where instruction occurs. All materials and computer software will be provided by these organizations.

Mr. Joseph Alfano is the Executive Director of the Training and Employment Council of South Florida.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent or his designee to enter into a cooperative agreement with the Training and Employment Council of South Florida, to provide tutorial services to Summer Youth Employment and Training Program and Stay-In-School Program students, from July 1, 2001 through September 30, 2001.
