SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR FUNDING THE FLORIDA LEARN AND SERVE CAPACITY-BUILDING PROGRAM; PROJECT CYCLE: MAY 14, 2001 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2001

The Florida Department of Education issued a Request for Proposals to Learn and Serve grantees for a Capacity-Building grant. These funds represent the remaining balance from the Florida Learn and Serve America Grant Program funded under the Corporation for National Service. The goal of the program is to expand service-learning training and service-learning curricula development that link with State standards.

Grant funds have been awarded to the Bureau of Community Services' Intergenerational Program in the total amount of \$12,000. Funds will cover part-time salaries for curriculum writers, training for project teachers, materials and supplies. The projects will focus on infusing community studies and oral history documentation into social studies and English/journalism classes.

During the 2000 - 2001 school year, the Miami-Dade County Public Schools' Bureau of Community Services received funds in the amount of \$46,903 under this funding initiative.

Official notification relative to this grant award was received on June 1, 2001. The budget period for this award allows for the reimbursement of expenditures beginning May 14, 2001.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- 1. accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education, in the amount of \$12,000, for funding the Florida Learn and Serve Capacity-Building Program; Project Cycle: May 14, 2001 through June 30, 2001;
- 2. extend this grant award, at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if deemed necessary, in order to complete the scope of the project; and
- 3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
