REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE SOUTH FLORIDA EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING CONSORTIUM (SFETC) AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH SFETC FOR FUNDING TO IMPLEMENT THE 2001 OFFICE OF COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT SUMMER YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM; PROJECT CYCLE: APRIL 27, 2001 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2001

Authorization is requested for the Superintendent to accept a grant award in the amount of \$279,000 from the South Florida Employment and Training Consortium (SFETC), and enter into a contractual agreement with SFETC whereby Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) will provide summer youth activities for 200 students for the Office of Community and Economic Development (OCED) Summer Youth Employment Program.

The SFETC is contracting with M-DCPS to provide work experience opportunities. M-DCPS will enroll participants in a paid work experience program, for approximately 160 hours, from June 18, 2001 through September 30, 2001. Students will earn \$5.15 per hour, except for lead workers who may be paid at the rate of \$5.50 per hour. M-DCPS staff will conduct the recruitment, intake eligibility, counseling, case management, recordkeeping, and data gathering functions, as well as track the participants' work hours and attendance, prepare payroll, issue checks to participants, and monitor work performance.

All participating youth must meet OCED eligibility requirements that include:

 Being residents of the Empowerment Zone or one of the following OCED Focus Areas:

Opa-locka Melrose
West Little River Leisure City
Model City Goulds
South Miami Perrine

Coconut Grove

 Having a family income at or below 80 percent of the Lower Level Standard Income Level. Mr. Joseph Alfano is the Executive Director of the Employment and Training Council of South Florida.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED:

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- 1. accept a grant award, in the amount of \$279,000, from the South Florida Employment and Training Consortium (SFETC) and enter into a contractual agreement with SFETC, in the amount of \$279,000, for funding to implement the 2001 Office of Community and Economic Development Summer Youth Employment Program; Project Cycle: April 27, 2001 through September 30, 2001;
- extend this grant award and contractual agreement, at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if it is deemed necessary in order to complete the scope of the project; and
- 4. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
