SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD

FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR FUNDING UNDER TITLE VI – CLASS-SIZE REDUCTION PROGRAM, IMPROVING AMERICA'S SCHOOLS ACT; PROJECT CYCLE: JULY 1, 2001

THROUGH JUNE 30, 2002

The purpose of the federal Class-Size Reduction Program (CSR) is to continue to improve student achievement and ensure that all children receive more individualized attention. The goal of the CSR Program is to help schools improve student achievement by adding additional highly qualified teachers to the workforce to ensure that class size, particularly in the early grades, is reduced to no more than 18 children per class.

The CSR Program is designed to complement other federal, state and local programs that have related purposes. Local Educational Agencies (LEA) must use CSR funds to supplement and not replace funds received from those state initiatives, so that the LEA can implement greater class size reductions than the LEA would have been able to accomplish under the state initiatives alone. During the 2000-2001 school year, Miami-Dade County Public Schools received \$12,392,413 under this initiative. Funds were used to reduce the teacher/student ratio to 1:18 in the 26 selected schools. The 2001-2002 allocation for the CSR Program is \$13,237,490. Funds will be used to sustain the CSR model in the 26 selected schools, and for professional development and teacher recruitment. Pending review of funding, other Level 2 schools with high concentrations of low-income students may be included in the CSR Program.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education, in the amount of \$13,237,490, for funding under Title VI – Class-Size Reduction Program, Improving America's Schools Act; Project Cycle: July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2002;
- 2. extend this grant award, at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if deemed necessary, in order to fully expend the grant award and thus complete the scope of the project; and
- 3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
