REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A CONTINUATION GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND ENTER INTO INDIVIDUAL CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENTS WITH CONTRACTORS TO IMPLEMENT THE COMPREHENSIVE SCHOOL REFORM DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM; PROJECT CYCLE: MARCH 16, 2001 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2001

At the Board Meeting of July 14, 1999, the School Board accepted funds in the amount of \$1,200,000 from the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) to implement the Comprehensive School Reform Demonstration Program (CSRD) in 24 Miami-Dade County Public Schools. In 2000, second year funding was awarded in the amount of \$1,888,864. The program is designed to support activities that are research-based and lead to coherent schoolwide improvements which include all aspects of a school's operation. Each school has selected a research-based model from several that were recommended and approved by the FDOE.

Funds in the amount of \$1,160,672 have been awarded for the third year of the program and will be used to implement each school's selected model program.

Authorization is requested to enter into separate contractual agreements with contractors associated with each research-based model in an amount not to exceed \$50,464 per school. The contractors will provide professional and technical services to implement the models. The schools that are requesting contracted services appear below:

- 2. extend this grant award and contractual agreements, at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if deemed necessary, in order to complete the scope of the project; and
- 3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
