SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR FUNDING UNDER THE 21st CENTURY COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTERS PROGRAM; PROJECT CYCLE: JUNE 1, 2001 THROUGH MAY 31, 2004

The United States Department of Education 21st Century Community Learning Centers Program under the United States Department of Education was authorized by Congress to award grants to rural and inner-city public schools, or consortia of such schools, to enable them to plan, implement, or expand projects that benefit the educational, health, social services, cultural and recreational needs of the community. Authorization is being requested to accept a grant award in the total amount of \$1,500,001.

The purpose of the grant is to enhance after-school and evening programs at North County Community School, Carol City Elementary School, Carol City Middle School, and Lake Stevens Middle School. The goal of the project is to create four self-sustaining high quality Centers that will be local, state, and national models for the 21st Century. To attain this goal, M-DCPS will partner with community businesses, agencies, churches, and public and private organizations in Miami. This partnership will provide an integrated array of programs to address the educational, safety, health, and employment needs in this community. The anticipated outcomes for the project include:

- higher academic achievement in core subjects to meet Florida standards;
- decreases in disciplinary referrals, suspensions, and school drop-outs;
- improved literacy and technology skills for students and their families; and
- increased access to health, recreation, cultural, social services, and prevention programs for families.

Funds will be used for personnel, materials, supplies, travel, and contracted services. The required in-kind contributions will be met through personnel, materials, communications, and building facilities.

Official notification relative to this grant award was received May 30, 2001. The budget period for this grant award allows for the reimbursement of expenditures beginning June 1, 2001.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- accept a grant award from the United States Department of Education, in the total amount of \$1,500,001, for funding under the 21st Century Community Learning Centers Program; Project Cycle: June 1, 2001 through May 31, 2004;
- 2. extend this grant award, at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if deemed necessary, in order to complete the scope of the project; and
- 3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amount approved by the granting agency, such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
