At its meeting of June 21, 2000, the Board commissioned 3D/International, Inc. as CM-at-Risk for Biscayne Elementary School. This contract provides for construction services to the Board and a Guaranteed Maximum Price for construction.

The Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) by the Construction Manager, 3D/International, Inc. is in the sum of \$149,352 (contingency of \$7,112 is included) which covers all required work and includes subcontracts, materials, contingency, general conditions, bond, and overhead and profit.
