**SUBJECT: ACCEPTANCE OF RESIGNATION
THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA v.
MARITZA VENTA - CASE NO. DH 00-009 DAISE**

At its regularly scheduled meeting of January 17, 2001, the School Board took action to suspend and dismiss school bus driver Maritza Venta from all employment for just cause, including deficient performance. The bus driver requested a hearing which had been scheduled for June 8, 2001. On June 6, 2001, the employee tendered her resignation from the Miami-Dade County Public Schools.

It is recommended that the resignation be accepted as achieving the objective sought by the School Board in this case. Acceptance of the resignation does not alter the employee's non-entitlement to accrued sick leave, if any.

Acceptance of the resignation, forwarded under separate cover, will obviate the requirement for further legal actions by the School Board.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida accept the resignation of Maritza Venta, school bus driver, effective June 20, 2001, at the close of the workday.
