**SUBJECT: RENEWAL OF PERMIT AGREEMENT WITH MIAMI-DADE COUNTY FOR THE PLACEMENT OF ONE BOARD-OWNED PORTABLE CLASSROOM FOR USE BY THE MIGRANT CHILD PROGRAM AT ROYAL COLONIAL MOBILE HOME ESTATES**

Since December 1994, the Board has leased a portion of the Royal Colonial Mobile Home Estates for the placement of portable classrooms for the operation of the Migrant Child Program. The District currently has one portable classroom still in place. The land is owned by Miami-Dade County (County) and is being leased to the Board under a permit agreement. The current term of the permit agreement will expire on August 31, 2001.

All terms and conditions of the permit agreement will remain unchanged, including the annual rental amount of \$1.00. The term of the renewal option period will commence September 1, 2001, and will end August 31, 2002. This renewal represents the only renewal option period available under the permit agreement. No physical improvements requiring the use of District funds are necessary as a result of the proposed Board action.

The Executive Director of the Migrant Program, Associate Superintendent of School Operations, and Deputy Superintendent of School Operations recommend approval of the permit agreement renewal.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the renewal of the permit agreement with Miami-Dade County for the placement of one Board-owned Migrant Child Program portable classroom, at an annual rental amount of \$1.00. The term of the renewal option period will commence September 1, 2001, and will end August 31, 2002. All other terms and conditions of the permit agreement will remain unchanged.

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
