**SUBJECT: MINORITY/WOMEN BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PROGRAM  
ANNUAL EXPENDITURE REPORT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR  
ENDED JUNE 30, 2000**

Miami-Dade County Public Schools has provided numerous economic opportunities to businesses owned by minorities and women through the Business Development and Assistance (BD&A) Program. For the fiscal year that ended June 30, 2000, the school district spent more than \$117.5 million, with approximately 290 certified minority and women-owned businesses.

The accompanying report delineates the distribution of expenditures with minority and women-owned businesses. The report has been reviewed by the Office of Management and Compliance Audits, which has concluded that the expenditure data has been properly compiled and reported.

Copies of this report will be distributed to Board Members, the Superintendent of Schools and appropriate district staff, and will be placed on file in the Office of the Recording Secretary to the School Board, and in the Citizen Information Center. The assistance levels will be transmitted under separate cover.
