SUBJECT: ACCEPTANCE OF RESIGNATION

THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA v. WILLIAM BROWN - CASE NO. DH 00-002 SPATZ

On September 13, 2000, the School Board suspended custodian William Brown from his employment with The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, and initiated dismissal proceedings against him for just cause, including, but not limited to, violations of School Board Rules 6Gx13-4-1.09, Employee-Student Relationships, and 6Gx13-4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties. The employee requested a hearing, but subsequently tendered his resignation from the Miami-Dade County Public Schools on August 1, 2001.

It is recommended that the resignation be accepted as achieving the objective sought by the School Board in this case. Acceptance of the resignation, forwarded under separate cover, will obviate the requirement for further legal actions by the School Board.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida accept the resignation of William Brown, custodian, effective August 22, 2001, at the close of the workday.
