**SUBJECT: THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA v.
WILNER SAINT JUSTE - DOAH CASE NO. 00-2937**

On July 19, 2000, the School Board suspended teacher Wilner Saint Juste from his employment with]revised
The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, and initiated dismissal proceedings against him
for misconduct in office and violations of School Board Rules 6Gx13-4A-1.21, *Responsibilities and*
Duties, and 6Gx13-5D-1.07, *Corporal Punishment-Prohibited*. A hearing was requested and the
case was tried on February 28 and March 1, 2001, before DOAH Administrative Law Judge Claude]revised
B. Arrington in Miami, Florida.

By recommended order entered July 18, 2001, the Administrative Law Judge sustained the School
Board's charges and recommended that the School Board enter a final order upholding the
employee's suspension without pay and terminating Wilner Saint Juste's employment contract.]revised

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida enter a final order in
the case of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida v. Wilner Saint
Juste, DOAH Case No. 00-2937, adopting the Administrative Law Judge's
Recommended Order upholding the suspension without pay of Wilner Saint
Juste terminating his professional services contract and terminating his]revised
employment with The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, as of
July 19, 2000, and denying any claim for back pay.
