SUBJECT: REQUEST AUTHORIZATION FOR THE SUPERINTENDENT TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, FOR A CORRECTIONS EDUCATION CONTINUATION GRANT FUNDED UNDER THE ADULT AND FAMILY LITERACY ACT; PROJECT CYCLE: JULY 1, 2001 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2002

The Bureau of Adult/Vocational, Alternative and Dropout Prevention Programs developed and submitted a grant application in June 2001, designed to provide tutoring services to incarcerated youth at the Turner Guilford Knight and Metro West Correctional facilities. Authorization is requested for the Superintendent to accept this grant award from the Florida Department of Education, in the amount of \$50,000, for corrections education. The Corrections Education project will provide supplemental materials, equipment, software, and other items needed for instructional activities at Turner Guilford Knight and Metro West Correctional facilities, by teachers from Miami-Dade County Public Schools.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. Accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education for a Corrections Education Continuation Grant funded under the Adult and Family Literacy Act, in the amount of \$50,000; Project Cycle: July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2002;
2. Extend this grant award, at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if deemed necessary, in order to complete the scope of the project; and
3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amount approved by the granting agency with such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
