SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH THE URBAN LEAGUE OF GREATER MIAMI, INC., FOR FUNDING THE CHILD EMPOWERMENT ZONE'S PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT PROJECT; PROJECT CYCLE: AUGUST 29, 2001 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2002

At the June 20, 2001 School Board meeting, the Title VI Innovative Education Program Strategies Grant was approved in the amount of \$3,153,376. Authorization is being requested to enter into a contractual agreement with the Urban League of Greater Miami, Inc., in the amount of \$36,281, for funding the Child Empowerment Zone's Parental Involvement Project. The purpose of the project is to provide assistance and training to parents of low-performing students in Regions III and IV. The training will focus on helping parents to better understand the methods and responsibilities for supporting improved student achievement and meeting the standards of educational excellence.

Funding for the Title VI grant is included in the 2001-02 Budget in Fund 0420, Object 5310, Location 9616, Program 3202, and Function 9100.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to enter into a contractual agreement with the Urban League of Greater Miami, Inc., in the amount of \$36,281, for funding the Child Empowerment Zone's Parental Involvement Project, Project Cycle: August 29, 2001 through June 30, 2002.
