SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR FUNDING UNDER THE HOMELESS CHILDREN AND YOUTH GRANT PROGRAM; PROJECT

CYCLE: JULY 1, 2001 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2002

The Florida Department of Education (FDOE) has received a grant award from the United States Department of Education for the Homeless Children and Youth Program. These funds were awarded to school districts through a competitive grant process.

Beginning in 1992, the Division of Student Services submitted a grant proposal, entitled Project Up-Start, to acquire funding to provide homeless assistance services to parents and students. The goal of the program is to address the academic needs of all homeless children and youth, including preschool children. Some of the services provided by the program include after school tutorial help and sensitivity awareness training for teachers and other school staff.

This will be the ninth year for Project Up-Start. The number of homeless children served has increased since the program's inception. As a result, the project's outreach activities continue to expand. Funding in the amount of \$115,000 for the fiscal year 2001-2002 will be used for personnel costs: one full-time position and several part-time personnel, printing and duplicating supplies and travel.

No local funds are required to fund this program.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- 1. accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education in the amount of \$115,000, for funding under the Homeless Children and Youth Grant Program; Project Cycle: July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2002;
- 2. extend this award, at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if deemed necessary, in order to fully expend the grant award and thus complete the scope of the project; and
- 3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency, such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
