SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE TAKE STOCK IN CHILDREN FOUNDATION, TO FUND A FULL-TIME POSITION FOR IDENTIFYING, RECRUITING, TRAINING, AND PLACING MENTORS WITH STUDENTS TO IMPROVE ACHIEVEMENT IN MATHEMATICS, SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY; PROJECT CYCLE: AUGUST 23, 2001 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2002

The Take Stock in Children Foundation (TSIC), is a non-profit organization which provides college scholarships to at-risk children in the Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) and across the state of Florida. TSIC, through the Toyota USA Foundation, is providing these funds for the purpose of identifying, recruiting, and training 100 mentor/volunteer mentors with expertise in the fields of mathematics, science, and technology. These mentors will be paired with 100 TSIC students who are potential scholarship recipients.

During the 2001-2002 school year, approximately 500 students will be served by the program. Students are selected for participation by school-site administrators, counselors, teachers, community college personnel, and TSIC staff. Funds in the amount of \$50,000 will be used for personnel, field trips, supplies and materials.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, authorize the Superintendent to accept a grant award from the Take Stock in Children Foundation, in the amount of \$50,000, to fund a full-time position for identifying, recruiting, training and placing mentors with students to improve achievement in mathematics, science and technology; Project Cycle: August 23, 2001 through June 30, 2002.
