**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH SHAKE-A-LEG MIAMI, TO DEVELOP AN AFTER SCHOOL PHYSICAL ACTIVITY PROGRAM; PROJECT CYCLE: NOVEMBER 1, 2001 THROUGH JUNE 7, 2002**

Authorization is requested for the Superintendent to accept funds in the amount of \$87,494 from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and to enter into a contractual agreement with Shake-A-Leg Miami to develop an after school physical activity program for children ages 9-14. Funding will provide instructional services and transportation to and from the Shake-A-Leg Watersports Center for students enrolled in four Community Educational Centers: Ponce de Leon Middle School, Biscayne Elementary School, Riverside Elementary School, and Silver Bluff Elementary School. Students involved in this program will be introduced to a variety of watersport and outdoor environmental activities designed to increase physical activity opportunities, enhance scientific knowledge through environmental education, facilitate cooperative learning, build positive self concept, and foster skills in teamwork and physical fitness.

Grant funds in the amount of \$87,494 will cover transportation services, supplies and administrative costs.

No local funds are required.

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**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept a grant award from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, in the amount of \$87,494, and enter into a contractual agreement, in the amount of \$87,494, with Shake-A-Leg Miami to develop an after school physical activity program; Project Cycle: November 1, 2001 through June 7, 2002;
2. extend this grant award and contractual agreement, at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if deemed necessary, in order to fully expend the grant award and complete the scope of the project; and
3. Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency with such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
