**SUBJECT: RENEW BID NO. 057-AA09 – SANITATION SERVICES AND
CLEANING SUPPLY**

The purpose of this bid, opened on November 16, 2001, was to establish a contract, to purchase, at firm unit prices, quantities, as may be required, of sanitation and cleaning supply services, for the Department of Food and Nutrition. The terms of agreement, as contained in the subject bid, awarded by the Board on February 14, 2001, provided, that by mutual agreement between the successful vendor and The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, the contract may be renewed for two (2) additional one (1) year periods. The contract is currently in its initial year. The awardee has agreed to renew for the first one (1) year renewal period, by letter, on file. It is considered to be in the best interest of the Board to renew this bid, for an additional one (1) year period, at the current prices, to benefit from fixed prices, during the next twelve (12) months, inasmuch as the Consumer Price Index (CPI), as of July 2001, indicated an increase of 2.7%.
