SUBJECT: PARTIAL AWARD BID NO. 120-AA06 – FIRST-AID SUPPLIES

The purpose of this bid, opened on April 3, 2001, is to establish a contract, to purchase, at firm unit prices, quantities, as may be required, of first-aid supplies, for Stores and Mail Distribution stock. This is a term bid which states that the Board may purchase quantities, as may be required, at the unit price bid, but is not obligated to purchase any guaranteed amount. Of 93 vendors sent bid forms or card notices of this advertised bid, 22 responded, with 20 bids meeting specifications (includes 7 bids meeting individual item specifications, but not all item specifications; not all vendors bid all items) and 2 no bids.

ACMJ Corporation, of Miami, Florida, made an error in pricing, on Item 1 - Alcohol, isopropyl, 70% by volume and has elected by letter, on file, to pay the bid liquidated damages in the amount of \$24 (check submitted), pursuant to Board Rule 6Gx13- 3C-1.08 -- Performance And Payment Security, Declining A Bid Award And Bonding Company Qualifications.

Inasmuch as all bids submitted for Item 18 - Safety pins, assorted sizes, stainless steel, did not meet specifications, the recommendation reflects that all bids be rejected. Competitive prices will be solicited for this item, as the need arises, pursuant to Board Rule 6Gx13- 3C-1.111 -- Bidding Process -- Competitive Bidding Requirements, which describes the procedures and guidelines to be used for bidding based on the estimated dollar expenditure.

Item 19 - Soap, liquid, antiseptic is being held for evaluation and will be scheduled for recommendation of award at the Board meeting of December 12, 2001.
