SUBJECT: RENEW BID NO. 041-ZZ04 – DISTRICT SOFTWARE LICENSING AND SPECIAL PURCHASING AGREEMENT

The purpose of this bid, opened on November 2, 1999, was to establish a contract, with a maximum of two (2) vendors as providers/managers of software licensing agreements for comprehensive educational software, to various school locations. The terms of agreement, as contained in the subject bid, awarded by the Board on December 8, 1999, provided, that by mutual agreement between the successful vendors and The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, the contract may be renewed for three (3) additional one (1) year periods. The contract is currently in its initial contract period. The awardees have agreed to renew for the first one (1) year renewal period, by letter, on file. It is considered to be in the best interest of the Board to renew this bid, for an additional one (1) year period, at the current prices, to benefit from fixed prices, during the next twelve (12) months, inasmuch as the Consumer Price Index (CPI), as of July 2001, indicated an increase of 2.7%.
