SUBJECT: THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA v. GREGORY ADAMS - DOAH CASE NO. 01-1131; THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA v. BRETT T. SCANLON - DOAH CASE NO. 01-1132

On March 14, 2001, the School Board suspended teachers Gregory Adams and Brett T. Scanlon from their employment with The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, and initiated dismissal proceedings against them for misconduct in office; violations of School Board Rules 6Gx13-4A-1.21, *Responsibilities and Duties*; 6Gx13-4-1.08, *Violence in the Workplace*; 6Gx13-5D-1.07, *Corporal Punishment - Prohibited*; 6Gx13-5D-1.08, *Guideline #24, Child Abuse* and violations of the Principles of Professional Conduct in the Education Profession and The Code of Ethics of the Education Profession in Florida. A hearing was requested and the case was tried on May 14-25 and September 14, 2001, before DOAH Administrative Law Judge Florence Snyder Rivas in Miami, Florida.

On October 26, 2001, the Administrative Law Judge entered a final order.
