SUBJECT: AWARD REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS NO. 023-BB10 - COUNSELING SERVICES FOR REFUGEE STUDENTS AND THEIR FAMILIES

The purpose of this Request For Proposals, opened on November 27, 2001, is to establish a contract, to provide weekly group and/or individual counseling to refugee students and their families, who have been affected by trauma, for the Division of Student Services. This is a term proposal which states that the Board may purchase quantities, as may be required, at the unit price proposed, but is not obligated to purchase any guaranteed amount. Of 72 proposers sent proposal forms or card notices of this advertised proposal, 4 responded, with 4 proposals meeting specifications.
